Petitioner, Tedor Davido, has filed a petition for writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case. The response in this matter is due November 24, 2025. Respondent is unable to comply with the current deadline and respectfully requests thirty days to complete the required response.

This is respondent's third request for extension of time. The undersigned has numerous other matters with pre-existing deadlines. Among other matters, the undersigned has argument scheduled in the Pennsylvania Supreme Court on November 20, 2025. Complicating matters further, on August 9, 2025, a cyber incident caused a significant disruption in operations at the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General. Though file access has improved, technology limitations remain significant and file access remains limited. As chief of the appeals and grand jury section for the office, the undersigned has been tasked with significant additional responsibilities during this resource disruption.

Respondent respectfully requests an extension of thirty days, or until December 24, 2025. Petitioner's counsel, Jennifer Chiccarino, Esq., has indicated that petitioner does not object to the requested extension.
