## MOTION TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Petitioner, Kayle Barrington Bates, respectfully requests leave of this Court, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, to proceed *in forma pauperis* (IFP) in connection with his application for a stay of execution and petition for a writ of certiorari filed on August 17, 2025. Mr. Bates is an indigent prisoner on Florida's death row with a scheduled execution for August 19, 2025, at 6:00 pm ET.

Mr. Bates has previously been granted IFP status by Florida's state and federal courts. The United States District Court for the Northern District of Florida appointed counsel under 18 U.S.C. § 3599 on May 15, 2009, in Case No. 5:09-CV-00081, and has continued to be represented under § 3599 by the Office of the Federal Public Defender for the Northern District of Florida, Capital Habeas Unit. See Harbison v. Bell, 556 U.S. 180, 185-86, 188 (2009) (finding appointment of federal

counsel under 18 U.S.C. § 3599 includes all proceedings occurring subsequent to the appointment).

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, Mr. Bates respectfully requests that this Court permit him to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
