MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

The petitioner, Willie Jenkins, seeks leave to file the attached petition for a writ of certiorari without prepayment of costs and to proceed in forma pauperis.

Mr. Jenkins, currently incarcerated on Texas's death row, is represented by the Office of Capital and Forensic Writs, a state public defender agency charged with representing indigent individuals in state post-conviction proceedings. On June 19, 2013, the 274th District Court, Texas, made a finding that Mr. Jenkins was indigent, and thereafter appointed the Office of Capital and Forensic Writs to represent Mr. Jenkins in state post-conviction proceedings pursuant to Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Article 11.071, Section 2. In addition, Mr. Jenkins has been granted leave to proceed in forma pauperis during the entire history of this state post-conviction matter, including in proceedings below before the Texas Court of Criminal Appeals.

Wherefore, Mr. Jenkins moves this Court for leave to file the attached petition for writ of certiorari in forma pauperis.
