The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on May 14, 2025, and placed on the Court's docket on August 27, 2025. The government's response is now due, after one extension, on November 17, 2025. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including December 10, 2025, within which to file a response.
