ORDER

Before **HOLMES**, Chief Circuit Judge.

This matter is before the court *sua sponte* following the issuance of a separate order certifying three issues for appeal pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(l)(B). Based upon the Motion for Leave to Proceed on Appeal Without Prepayment of Costs or Fees filed by Mr. Barragan-Guiterrez on May 16, 2023, he is financially eligible for the appointment of counsel under 18 U.S.C. § 3006A. Because the interests of justice so require, Adam Mueller is appointed to represent Mr. Barragan-Guiterrez in this appeal pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(a)(2)(B). Within 7 days of the date of this order, Mr. Mueller shall file an entry of appearance.

The record on appeal filed May 18, 2023 is available via CM/ECF and PACER.

Mr. Mueller or counsel for the United States may move to supplement the record on appeal as necessary. No appendix need be filed.

No later than forty days from the date of this order, Mr. Mueller shall file a supplemental opening brief addressing the issues certified for appeal. The government shall then file a response brief, and counsel for Mr. Barragan-Guiterrez may file an optional reply brief according to the deadlines established in Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 31(a)(1). All briefs must comply with all applicable Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and Tenth Circuit Rules.

The Clerk shall send a copy of this order to Mr. Barragan-Guiterrez, Mr. Mueller, and counsel for the United States.
