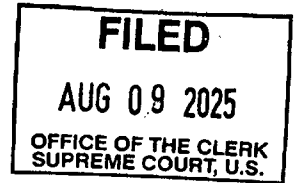

STATUTES AND RULES

Arkansas Supreme Court Rule 1-2(a)(2)(2014)

"The State filed first-degree-murder charges against me. At trial I asserted the defense of not guilty by reason of mental disease or defect but after the jurors heard the testimony of expert witnesses on both sides, they rejected the defense and found me guilty of first-degree murder." I was sentenced to life imprisonment.

OTHER

Due to The Fair Sentencing of Minors Act of 2017 Act 539 I got granted a Transfer eligibility date of 12-2-2037, but I still have a sentence of life with a discharge date of life

CONSTITUTIONAL AND STATUTORY PROVISIONS INVOLVED

It is an injustice and unconstitutional to unlawfully detain a minor in an adult detention center. I should have had the right jurisdiction because the Circuit Court erred when it lacked juvenile jurisdiction transfer to a juvenile ~~detention~~ detention center and held me against my will in an adult jail for 10 months prior to my 18th birthday. I should have also had my record cleared and sealed of all other juvenile offenses when I turned 18 years old. The trial court was disorderly and unconstitutional in my opinion.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

I was falsely accused and wrongly convicted of first-degree murder, and the opinions of the prosecutors at a jury trial that I had to await trial for, to be trialed as an adult for accusation that was held against me when I was a 17 year old minor

Mr. Loyd Cole, an ~~and~~ 80 year old Korean War Vet died by being stabbed to death by a jack knife I owned that was stolen from Walmart by my ex-boyfriend.

I pleaded Not Guilty with a directed verdict of Not Guilty by reason of mental disease or defect. Currently I'm diagnosed with Schizophrenia.

REASONS FOR GRANTING THE PETITION

The reasons I ask to be granted the petition is because I have been incarcerated approx. 13 years. I think I did my time, and I learned my lesson. I apply to Act 539, The Fair Sentencing of Minors Act of 2017, and since I was a minor at the time of the crime, I think I deserve a 2nd Chance at life and to have a discharge date or to be let free with a full pardon with mercy on my soul. May Loyd Cole Rest in Peace.

CONCLUSION

The petition for a writ of certiorari should be granted.
