The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on August 20, 2025, and placed on the Court's docket on October 22, 2025. The government's response is now due, after one extension, on January 12, 2025. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including February 11, 2025, within which to file a response.
