Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, the State of Louisiana respectfully requests an extension of 30 days, to and including March 30, 2026, within which to file its brief in opposition to the petition for writ of certiorari in *Galbraith v. Vannoy*, No. 25-6213. The Court docketed the petition on November 12, 2025. The State filed a response waiver on December 15, 2025. The Court requested a response on December 29, 2025. On January 7, 2026, the Court granted a 30-day extension for the State's brief in opposition, which is currently due on February 27, 2026.

This is the State's second request for an extension of time. The extension is needed in light of other deadlines and conflicts faced by undersigned counsel of record for the State, including a reply brief due on February 17 in *Louisiana v. FDA*, No. 25-cv-1491 (W.D. La.); oral argument at a preliminary-injunction hearing in *Louisiana v. FDA* on February 24; and a brief in opposition in a capital case, *Robinson v. Vannoy*, No. 25-6549 (U.S.), due on March 13, 2026.
