MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

Petitioner Vincent Gerald Garcia (“Petitioner” or “Mr. Garcia”) requests leave to file the attached petition for writ of certiorari without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
