Defendant Sam Boyd made his initial appearance in this matter on Wednesday, February 2, 2022 and requested court-appointed counsel. Ashley Parr was appointed to represent Mr. Boyd. Mr. Boyd wrote a letter to the court (Doc. 67) requesting that Mr. Parr be dismissed from the case. A hearing was held on the motion for new counsel on July 15, 2022. Mr. Boyd informed the court that he was requesting that replacement counsel be appointed, and stated that attorney-client relations have deteriorated to the place where there is an irreconcilable conflict. Good cause appearing, it is hereby

ORDERED that Mr. Boyd's motion for new counsel (Doc. 67) is granted. It is further

ORDERED that Conor Duffy is appointed as replacement CJA counsel.

It is further

ORDERED that Mr. Parr shall turn over to succeeding counsel all pleadings received and filed to date in Mr. Boyd's case, and shall cooperate

with succeeding counsel in providing a smooth transition for the benefit of Mr. Boyd. Mr. Parr shall turn over to the United States Attorney's Office all discovery provided by the government to him. It is further

ORDERED that the United States Attorney's Office shall promptly and at the earliest possible date re-provide discovery to Mr. Duffy. It is further

ORDERED that the Clerk's Office is directed to deliver a copy of this order to the United States Attorney's Office, Mr. Parr and Mr. Duffy.
