The USCA6 overlooked my petition for rehearing order filed: 11/18/24 in its order filed: 2/10/25 granting my motion to extend time to file a petition for rehearing that contains my petition for rehearing order filed: 11/18/24 before it dismissed USCA6, No. 24-5408 without hearing my petition for rehearing order filed: 11/18/24 due to its order filed: 3/6/25, in which I believe I was under imminent danger of serious physical harm under 28 U.S.C. Section 1915(g) when I alleged that, while in my cell, the workers threatened to stab me to death when I go to court or poison my food if I filed a grievance/lawsuit about the theft of my property that Fields/ subordinates paid the inmates to steal after I filed a lawsuit (USCA6, No. 24-5805) about flies and bed bugs biting me, in which I believe that the S. Ct. shall consolidate USCA6, Nos.: 24-5408 and 24-5805 in my petition for a writ of certiorari because case: ~~24~~-5408 is about Fields/ subordinates paying inmates to steal my property and making threats to cause me serious physical harm if I filed a grievance/lawsuit about the theft of my property in retaliation of me filing a lawsuit (USCA6, No. 24-5805) about flies and bed bugs biting me, in which the USCA6 violated my time to file a petition for rehearing after returning my petition for en banc rehearing order filed: 1/16/25 of USCA6, No. 24-5805, for the USDC/ USCA6 intentionally caused "cover ups" by not stating in their orders that I stated in my complaint/petition that I was being bitten by flies, bed bugs and roaches in 2-N-pod (at SCC JC) that had to be bomb sprayed at least three (3) times to kill millions of bugs which placed me in imminent danger of serious physical harm at the time I filed my complaint in 2023.
