ORDER

Anthony Roland filed a complaint against NBC Subsidiary (WMAQ-TV) LLC for conducting "unauthorized zoom" calls through his television, then broadcasting recordings of him, commenting on his appearance, and imitating his hand gestures back

at him. The district court dismissed the suit as frivolous, reflecting paranoid and delusional fears.

On appeal, Roland asserts that the court disregarded certain evidence that he attached to his amended complaint—(1) a digital recording of him waving and gesturing at the television while watching the Today Show and (2) affidavits from several witnesses attesting that they saw a "Zoom experience" violate Roland's right to privacy. But these materials add nothing to his implausible allegations that WMAQ-TV committed the Illinois tort of "intrusion on seclusion," W. Bend Mut. Ins. Co. v. Krishna Schaumburg Tan, Inc., 183 N.E.3d 47, 58 (Ill. 2021), or violated 19 U.S.C. § 1592, the civil penalty provision under the Tariff Act of 1930 for fraud, gross negligence, or negligence in importing merchandise. And to the extent Roland believes that the district court deprived him of due process by dismissing the case without a hearing, no evidentiary hearing is required when the factual allegations—as here—are incredible. Gladney v. Pendleton Corr. Facility, 302 F.3d 773, 774 (7th Cir. 2002). The district court rightly dismissed this case as frivolous. See, e.g., Lee v. Clinton, 209 F.3d 1025 (7th Cir. 2000).

We close with a word about sanctions. Since 2018, Roland has filed five frivolous cases in the Northern District of Illinois asserting unauthorized surveillance via television. He has appealed four of them, and all were dismissed. We now warn Roland that further repetitive and frivolous filings may result in sanctions, including fines that, if unpaid, may result in a bar on filing papers in civil lawsuits in any court within this circuit. See Support Sys. Int'l, Inc. v. Mack, 45 F.3d 185, 186 (7th Cir. 1995).

ORDER

The defendant's Motion to Dismiss [23] is granted. Civil case terminated.

STATEMENT

The plaintiff, Anthony Roland, pro se, sues the defendant NBC Subsidiary (WMAQ-TV) LLC ("NBC") for "intrusion on seclusion" (Count I) and negligence under 19 U.S.C. § 1592 (Count II). (R. 21 ((First Amended Complaint ("FAC")) ¶¶ 23–49.) NBC moves to dismiss for failing to state a claim. (R. 23.)

To survive a motion to dismiss, a complaint only needs to contain factual allegations that, when accepted as true, are sufficient to "state a claim that is plausible on its face." Ashcroft v. Iqbal, 556 U.S. 662, 678 (2009) (citing Bell Atlantic Corp. v. Twombly, 550 U.S. 544, 554–57 (2007)). Because the plaintiff initiated this action prose, his complaint is construed liberally. Perez v. Fenoglio, 792 F.3d 768, 776 (7th Cir. 2015). The court may read the complaint "broadly" and make necessary assumptions where the facts do not "definitely identify" the plaintiff's challenges. Obriecht v. Raemisch, 517 F.3d 489, 492 n.2 (7th Cir. 2008). The court, however, "need not accept as true statements of law or unsupported conclusory factual allegations." Bilek v. Fed. Ins. Co., 8 F.4th 581, 586 (7th Cir. 2021). Moreover, the Court may dismiss fantastic or delusional allegations. Lee v. Clinton, 209 F.3d 1025, 1026 (7th Cir. 2000); see also Dix v. Unknown TSA Agent No. 1, 588 F. App'x 499, 499 (7th Cir. 2015) (nonprecedential).

The plaintiff asserts that NBC is conducting "unauthorized zoom" calls through his television, then broadcasting footage of the plaintiff, commenting on his activities, and repeating his hand gestures back at him. (FAC $\P\P$ 8–11, 25–28.) The plaintiff asserts that strangers have acknowledged his appearance on television. (*Id.* \P 14). He also reports being stalked and attacked by strangers who were tired of seeing him on NBC. (*Id.* $\P\P$ 33–36.)

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The Court begins with Count II, the plaintiff's negligence claim under 19 U.S.C. § 1592. (Id. ¶ 40.) This statute concerns "penalties for fraud, gross negligence, and negligence" regarding imports and custom duties. 19 U.S.C. § 1592. The plaintiff does not allege any facts concerning imports or customs, and therefore Count II is dismissed.

Turning to Count I, the plaintiff's claim for "intrusion on seclusion," is a recognized cause of action in Illinois. Lawlor v. N. Am. Corp. of Illinois, 983 N.E.2d 414, 425 (Ill. 2012). However, even a liberal reading of the complaint reveals that the allegations are not plausible, but rather "reflects paranoid and delusional fears and is frivolous." Dix, 588 F. App'x. at 499 (affirming dismissal of a complaint alleging "a vast, nationwide conspiracy to rig the security equipment used at airports"). Count I is therefore dismissed. Lee, 209 F.3d at 1026.

Accordingly, the defendant's Motion to Dismiss is granted. This is the fourth time Mr. Roland has presented his claims of unauthorized surveillance via television to a federal court, and the fourth time they have been rejected. See Roland v. U.S. Department of Justice, No. 22 CV 1066, R. 76 (N.D. Ill. Mar. 15, 2023); Roland v. Pai, No. 19 CV 3128, R. 10 (N.D. Ill. June 11, 2019); Roland v. Fed. Gov't, No. 18 CV 5363, R. 11 (N.D. Ill. Aug. 28, 2018). Leave to amend is unjustified in these circumstances. Foman v. Davis, 371 U.S. 178, 182 (1962) (granting leave to amend is properly denied where amendment would be futile).

FIRST AMENDED COMPLAINT

GENERAL ALLEGATIONS

Plaintiff Anthony Roland *Pro se* brings this lawsuit against Defendant NBC Subsidiary (WMAQ-TV) LLC, under 19 U.S.C.§ 1592 and *Restatement of the Second of Torts Section 652*: Intrusion on Seclusion. I would respectfully explain the following.

In or around 2019 whistleblowers, associates, and family members started informing me that my expectation of privacy was/is being violated by NBC Subsidiary (WMAQ-TV), as if I am a host on their show through my home Television. A similar example would be during the COVID epidemic when game show guest would appear on the game shows using their TV or computer or when courts take Hearings via Zoom video.¹

I started recording my interaction with the TV commentator using my cellphone for video evidence to show the court or the defendant during a future deposition. I used several methods of notifying the defendant before taking legal action. I made phone calls to the network station none of the calls were returned, I wrote countless letters to their parent company and their registered

agent C T Corporation. I even made complaints to both outside government agencies FCC (Federal Communications Commission) and FTC (Federal Trade Commission) to resolve this unauthorized Zoom experience but never received any response.

This peculiar invasion of my privacy loosely calling it a Zoom hack has caused both physical and cognizable harm. I have been assaulted by strangers because they say that they're tired of my appearance on their NBC Subsidiary (WMAQ-TV) screen. I often have to take different routes to work and home because I am being stalked and threatened. Whenever given an opportunity I take written testimony of this cause of action some witnesses mention that they will even testify in court on my behalf.

Plaintiff *Pro se* Roland has now turned to this Honorable Court for injunctive relief and to find out the cause of this peculiar invasion of my expectation of privacy done with the <u>Fairness</u> of Federal Rules of Civil Procedure due process of *Discovery*.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

- This Complaint seeks remedies pursuant to 19 U.S.C. § 1592 and alleging violations under Restatement of the Second of Torts Section 652.
- 2. Jurisdiction is conferred upon this Honorable Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§1331, 1343, and 1367.
- 3. Venue is proper before this Honorable Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1391(b).

PARTIES

- 4. Plaintiff Anthony Roland is the *Pro Se* in this case also an American Citizen and a native of Chicago.
- Defendant NBC Subsidiary (WMAQ-TV) LLC is an owned subsidiary of NBCUniversal Media, LLC located at 454 North Columbus Drive, Chicago IL. 60611.
- NBCUniversal Media, LLC is a wholly owned and indirect subsidiary of Comcast Corporation.

FACTS Invasion of Privacy by Subsidiary NBC (WMAO-TV) LLC.

- 7. <u>Notification</u> I the Plaintiff do not have a background in Computer Engineering or know any Technical Jargon to explain the unauthorized Zoom I've experienced with (WMAQ-TV). I just used my phone to record my interactions and collect written testimonies. Furthermore, as a *Pro se*, I may show a disability with legal terminology.
- 8. In 2018 I noticed watching WMAQ-TV (channel 5) that the TV host commentator would make direct comments about what I was eating or wearing, at first I thought it was just a coincidence until it became repetitious.
- 9. On or about October 2018 I was at home watching channel 5 and while I was imitating a Golf swing the TV commentator lucidly said "Look Look he's taking another swing of the Golf club" I sat down confused, and then he said "now he's sitting down" after that day I started using my cellphone to record the unauthorized Zoom experience.
- 10. From 2018 to 2019 I started to get creative, I began alternating my strategy on capturing video evidence by using hand gestures and drawing pictures to get the corroboration from the TV host.

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- 11. I would put a peace sign at the commentator then the TV host would respond with their peace sign all while recording with my cell phone
- 12. I drew a hatchback car colored it blue and held it to show the TV host then on a commercial break there was an advertisement of the exact blue hatchback Toyota I drew and again recorded using my phone.
- 13. I used those two alternative strategies hand gestures and picture drawings capturing over 12 video evidence.
- 14. From 2018 2019 on my way to work or running errands, I would ask people if I was appearing on their Channel 5 television and occasionally they'd answer yes or they would assume I was involved, as if I was a part of the show.
- 15. I started typing my declaration explaining I was a victim of privacy violation done by (WMAQ-TV) Television station then asked <u>Witnesses</u> (strangers, associates, and family members) to sign my documents.
- 16. From 2018 2019 I began studying Civil Litigation.

Pro se Related Previous Fourth Amendment Lawsuit

- 17. From 2018 2022 I've written about three related lawsuits against the Government on my Fourth Amendment rights but because of being an amateur in litigation I never survived to Discovery.
- 18. On or around August 07, 2018, I filed my first lawsuit (Roland v. Federal Government No. 18-c-5363) the complaint didn't survive Discovery because I never issued a summons so the case was dismissed on Sua Sponte on August 28, 2018.

- 19. On or around May 09, 2019, my second *Pro se* Lawsuit (*Roland v. Pai et, al No. 19-cv-03128*) again for the same reasons as before the complaint did not survive *Discovery* and dismissed Sua Sponte on June 11, 2019.
- 20. The year 2021 was my worst year I lost my phone at work which had all of the video evidence I worked so hard and strategized for. That same year I also mishandled and misplaced my witness Affidavits.
- 21. Towards the end of 2021 I rush to acquire fresh evidence while studying to enhance my litigation skills.
- 22. On or around March 01, 2022, I filed my third lawsuit this time with both evidence and summons but my case (Roland v. U.S. Department of Justice No. 22-cv-01066) did not survive Discovery because I was denied due Process, I wasn't allowed a Meet and Confer.

COUNT ONE

Restatement of the Second of Tort Section 652: Intrusion on Seclusion

- 23. The Plaintiff realleges as through fully set forth at length, and included herein by reference, all of the allegation and statements contained in paragraphs 7 through 22 of the Facts, above and including.
- 24. Plaintiff Roland has Article III standing of this Intrusion on Seclusion claim because it evolves both Physical and Mental harm See Trans Union LLC. vs. Ramirez, 594 U.S. 413 (2021).
- 25. The Defendant NBC Subsidiary (WMAQ-TV) LLC., without authorization intentionally invaded Roland's expectation of privacy through a Zoom-like experience where I can be

exposed to the viewer and Host (See quoting Robbins vs. Lower Merion School

District No. 2:11-cv-07495-JP the suit alleged that in what was dubbed the "Webcam Gate" scandal the schools secretly spied on the students while they were in the privacy of their homes).

- 26. Plaintiff's violation of Intrusion on Seclusion by Defendant has been carried out via Zoom-like experience. Roland has noticed the privacy violations since on or around January 01,

 2018- Present.
- 27. On August 22, 2024, Plaintiff Roland uploaded a dated video clip in the same context as the past/current videos to this Honorable Court.
- 28. The video evidence shows the plaintiff watching The Today show on WMAQ-TV and waving to the TV commentators and receiving a wave back similar to via Zoom (fresh evidence is available upon the court's request). Exhibit A.
- 29. Plaintiff presumption video evidence can be proven by Laying a Foundation.
- 30. The recording device was capable of recording the video; A competent person operated the device; The recording can be authenticated by a subpoena; There have been no modifications to the recordings by both Plaintiff and Defendant's Technical experts; The speakers in the video can testify; and the conversation was made voluntary, in good faith.
- 31. Along with video evidence Plaintiff has resent collected an Affidavit and witness sign testaments Exhibit B C.
- 32. The Intrusion on Seclusion has caused Plaintiff physical harm and mental anguish.
- 33. Since 2018 Plaintiff Roland has been involved in 8 physical altercations linked to the Defendant.

- 34. While running errands or doing leisure activities Plaintiff would run into enraged strangers and they would start attacking I would ask why? They'd yelled, "TIRED OF YOU APPERING ON MY CHANNEL 5."
- 35. I often have to change my routes from home to work and back because of stalkers again linked to the Defendant.
- 36. On Several occasions I would see some of the same entity going back and forth from my house to work and out of curiosity, I asked why are you stalking me? They'd respond 'I see you on my Television."
- 37. The Combination of physical altercation and stalking has caused both mental anguish and suffering.
- 38. As a direct and proximate result of Invasion of Privacy: Intrusion on Seclusion by Defendant, Plaintiff Anthony Roland has suffered and continues to suffer from, including but not limited to being forced to live in isolation, suffering both mental and physical harm, public humiliation, anxiety, and loss of appetite. *Pro se* Roland is entitled to damages, including presumed economic damages, as a consequence of NBC Subsidiary (WMAQ-TV) LLC., above allegations.
- 39. Wherefore, Plaintiff Anthony Roland prays for Injunctive Relief against Invasion of Privacy and punitive damages to be \$40,000.00 (Forty Thousand Dollars) for the first time Defendant violated my expectation of privacy and \$20,000.00 (Twenty Thousand Dollars) thereafter and such other relief as this court deems just.

COUNT TWO

19 U.S.C. § 1592: Negligence against NBC Subsidiary (WMAQ-TV) LLC.

- 40. Plaintiff realleges as through fully set forth at length and incorporates herein by reference, all the allegations and statements contained in paragraphs 7 through 22 of the Facts, paragraphs 23 through 39 of Count One above and including.
- 41. The Defendant ignored their Legal Duty of Care by not taking reasonable actions before and after Plaintiff's several repetitive alternative methods of notifications.
- 42. First, the plaintiff made several calls to the Defendant Offices to stop the actions, but none of their administrative returned Roland's calls. Second, Plaintiff sent e-mails with attached video evidence for an explanation or a remedy of the cause. Third, Plaintiff frequently wrote detailed letters eventually followed by Cease and Desist to both NBC Subsidiary company and the parent company Comcast Corporation and all actions were neglected Exhibit D.
- 43. Finally, after being neglected Roland turned to two Government agencies to end the Intrusion on seclusion allegations, both are FCC (Federal Communications Commission) and FTC (Federal Trade Commission) again still no response Exhibit F.
- 44. Defendant had Foreseeable knowledge that the exposure from the Zoom-like circumstance would cause Plaintiff to have a barrage of physical attacks, mental anguish, and substantial risk.
- 45. If Plaintiff Roland had never been exposed to the Zoom-like circumstance by the defendant, no physical altercation, mental anguish, and Substantial risk would/will happen.
- 46. Both physical altercation and mental attack that occurred by the entity from the exposure resulted in extreme back aches, a sprained ankle, several bruises, and severe headaches. All entities pointed to the Defendant's platform for the Cause-In-Fact.

- 47. If however, the Defendant's Tech. Expert investigation shows that the Zoom activity is done by a hacker by some sort of malware the Plaintiff can still file a Negligence claim against WMAQ-TV by Subrogation, See M.S. vs. Amazom.com, Inc., No. 3:23-cv-0046 (S.D.W.Va. Nov. 30, 2023).²
- 48. As a direct and proximate result of Defendant Negligence, Plaintiff Roland has suffered and continues to suffer from, including but not limited to being forced to live in isolation, suffered both mental and physical harm, public humiliation, anxiety, and loss of appetite.
- 49. Because of the Defendant's negligence to establish a reasonable action, Plaintiff is entitled to punitive damages appropriate to the fullest extent permitted by law.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

Wherefore, The *Pro Se* Anthony Roland, respectfully demands judgment against the Defendant for:

- I. Permanent injunctive relief from a violation of privacy;
- II. General damages for all past and future physical pain, and mental anguish suffered by the Plaintiff;
- III. Punitive damages to the fullest extent permitted by law;
- IV. Order the Defendant to award whistleblower of any similar issue;
- V. Order the Defendant a mandatory 100-hour class on Human Rights, each staff member must complete the course with a 20-page essay on Privacy Rights.
- VI. Such other further specific and general relief as may become apparent from discovery.






