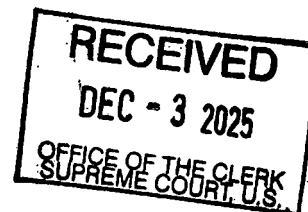




Rules of this Court and no changes to the substance of the petition have been made.
