Petitioner respectfully petitions for rehearing of this Court's Order entered February 23, 2026, denying the Petition for Writ of Certiorari.

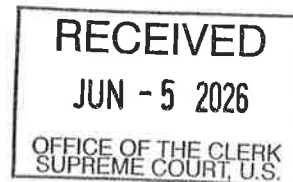
This Petition is submitted pursuant to Rule 44.2 of the Rules of this Court.

GROUND FOR REHEARING

Petitioner respectfully submits that rehearing is warranted based upon substantial grounds within the meaning of Rule 44.2.

The Petition for Writ of Certiorari presented extraordinary allegations of police brutality prior to trial, suppression of exculpatory evidence, judicial misconduct affecting pretrial rights, ineffective assistance of counsel, and fraud upon the court. These allegations involve structural constitutional errors that undermine the integrity of the judicial process.

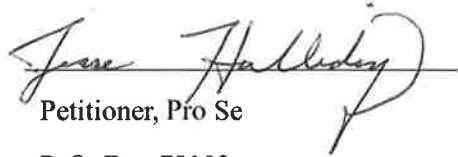
