Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, the State of Louisiana (through Warden Darrel Vannoy) respectfully requests an extension of 7 days, to and including April 20, 2026, within which to file its brief in opposition to the petition for writ of certiorari in *Robinson v. Vannoy*, No. 25-6549. Under Rule 15.1, the State is required to file a response in this capital case. On the grant of the State's prior motions for extensions of time, the State's brief in opposition is currently due on April 13, 2026.

The extension is needed in light of other deadlines and conflicts faced by undersigned counsel of record for the State during the existing briefing period, including: an amicus brief in *Guerrero v. Johnson*, No. 25-1003, filed on March 25; a brief in opposition in *Galbraith v. Vannoy*, No. 25-6213 (U.S.), filed on March 30; and a brief in opposition in *McElveen v. Louisiana*, No. 25-6922 (U.S.), due on April 15.

Counsel for petitioner does not oppose this requested final extension.
