SUPPLEMENTAL LETTER REGARDING INTERVENING DISTRICT COURT

DEVELOPMENTS (*Supreme Court Rules 15.8 and 20*)

Petitioner Angeliina L. Lawson, proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, respectfully submits this Supplemental Letter pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 15.8 to notify the Court of intervening developments in the underlying district court action occurring after Petitioner's most recent filing in this matter, while the Petition for Writ of Mandamus remains pending under Rule 20.

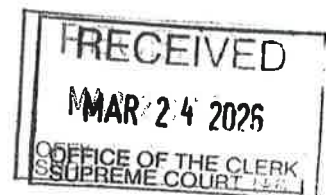
1. Intervening Developments in the Underlying District Court Case. In *Lawson v. Bolton et al.*, Case No. 2:25-cv-02251 (D. Kan.), the following events occurred:

- On March 12, 2026, the assigned magistrate judge issued a Report and Recommendation recommending dismissal of all claims under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(ii) and (iii) and recommending the Court decline supplemental jurisdiction over state-law claims.
- On March 18, 2026, the district court entered a docket notice reassigning the matter to a different magistrate judge.
- Also on March 18, 2026, Petitioner filed objections and procedural motions.
- Then the docket reflects that the new magistrate referral was removed as to those motions and that the district judge will resolve them.

2. Relevance to the Pending Mandamus Petition. These intervening events occurred after the case remained in a prolonged pre-service posture following in forma pauperis status and withheld summons/service. Petitioner submits this update because the sequence bears directly on the Petitioner's showing that:

- prolonged pre-service screening over ten months has functioned as a practical barrier to service, adversarial process, and reviewable adjudication; and
- the writ is sought in aid of this Court's supervisory and appellate jurisdiction where adequate alternative relief has not been available in the ordinary course.

Petitioner submits this letter to notify the Court of intervening docket events.
