Original jurisdiction is assumed. Petitioner's "Petition for Amended Writ of Prohibition" is denied.

By Order entered September 22, 2025, this Court vacated the only orders entered by Respondent after Petitioner filed his recusal request on July 30, 2025. Petitioner has not demonstrated that any other orders were entered in violation of District Court Rule 15 or should otherwise be vacated.

The Court notes Petitioner filed his recusal request the day after Respondent ruled orally from the bench that all defendants would be dismissed from the action and entered written orders dismissing Real Parties in Interest/Defendants Artus, Staton, and Levine and granting their motion for sanctions. This sequence of events indicates Petitioner made his recusal request with "an intention to disrupt or delay lower court proceedings." *Frazier v. Bruce*, 2021 OK 14, ¶3, 484 P.3d 285. Petitioner is admonished that future filings which are frivolous, lack legal or factual

support, or fail to comply with this Court's rules and orders will result in the imposition of sanctions, including an award of attorneys' fees to the responding parties.
