**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN
FORMA PAUPERIS**

The Petitioner, LESLEY C. GREEN, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, hereby moves this Court for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

1. Mr. Green was determined to be indigent pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A, by a judge of the United States District Court for the Middle District of Georgia. Undersigned counsel was appointed under the Criminal Justice Act to represent Mr. Green in the district court and on appeal before the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.

2. Mr. Green was arrested on a writ of habeas corpus on June 30, 2022, and has remained in federal custody since. Mr. Green was found guilty after a jury trial on August 17, 2023, and remains indigent. Through counsel, he will file in this Court a *Petition for a Writ of Certiorari* and wishes to do so *in forma pauperis*.

WHEREFORE Mr. Green asks this Court to grant his motion to allow him to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
