

CERTIFICATION

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 44.2, the undersigned hereby certifies that this petition for rehearing is restricted to the grounds specified in Rule 44.2, is presented in good faith, and is not presented for delay.

The undersigned further certifies that the grounds for rehearing consist of:

(1) Intervening circumstances of a substantial or controlling effect, specifically: (a) the New Hampshire Division of Motor Vehicles' issuance of a formal suspension notice dated February 20, 2026, effective March 23, 2026; (b) Petitioner's forced payment of the challenged fine and a \$100 restoration fee under compulsion and express protest, with reservation of all rights (Appendices A and B); and (c) adverse interstate driving record consequences arising from the challenged proceeding; and

(2) Other substantial grounds not previously presented with sufficient clarity, specifically the recurring and nationwide consequences of the constitutional question presented for nonresident defendants denied remote access to contest traffic citations.
