


MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

Petitioner asks leave to file the attached petition for a writ of certiorari without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, the Petitioner, SONNY RAMDEO, request that the Court grant him leave to *proceed in forma pauperis*. In support of his Motion, the Petitioner avers that:

1. Petitioner is unable to afford the cost of representation in this matter and remains in custody.

2. Proceeded pro se in these post-conviction proceedings and denied informa pauperis in the lower Court to proceed with an appeal and in the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals. Petitioner has been previously granted informa pauperis status in other matters related to his criminal conviction and collateral matters.



3. Petitioner has had no substantial change in circumstances to alter the previous factual finding that he proceed *in forma pauperis*. Petitioner's affidavit in support of this motion is attached hereto.

4. Because of his inability to afford counsel due in large part to the restitution order that is ultimately being challenged, this Court should permit him to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

WHEREFORE, the petitioner, SONNY RAMDEO, respectfully requests that he be allowed to proceed *in forma pauperis* without prepayment of filing fee or service of notice fees, and for such other relief as the Court deems just and proper.


