ORDER GRANTING DEFENSE COUNSEL'S MOTION TO WITHDRAW AND FOR APPOINTMENT OF APPELLATE COUNSEL AND FOR OTHER RELIEF

CAME TO BE HEARD upon Defense Counsel Edward A. Kramer's Motion to Withdraw and for Appointment of Appellate Counsel and for Other Relief, the Court, being advised in the premises, finds as follows, that:

1. Defendant was convicted of Sale of Schedule II Controlled Substance in a jury trial in Clarke County on January 8, 2024.
2. Defendant was previously found to be indigent and present counsel was appointed by the Court to represent the Defendant at trial.
3. Defendant remains indigent and cannot afford to hire appellate counsel nor pay filing fees nor pay the costs of the preparation of the record for appeal.

IT IS HEREBY CONSIDERED, ORDERED AND ADJUDGED, that:

1. Present counsel be allowed to withdraw;
2. Defendant is hereby found indigent and is hereby authorized to proceed with his appeal *in forma pauperis*;
3. The Indigent Appeal Division of the Office of State Public Defender is hereby appointed to represent Defendant for purposes of appeal, and that a copy of said order shall be sent to Director, Indigent Appeals Division, P.O. Box 3510, Jackson MS 39207; and

4. Appointed counsel is authorized to file the appeal out of time within thirty days of this order pursuant to MRAP Rule 4(g).
