My Financial Changes in the next 12 months

In response to question number 9, if my Petition is not heard, in a few months, I am facing a big change my income, assets and liabilities. Firstly, I am not employed and cannot find an employer to hire me at 64 years old, due to the termination record placed on me by Leidos Inc.

Leidos Inc. took away my livelihood, so close to my retirement. I had planned to work for an additional 4-6 more years until retirement, which would have enabled me pay-off my house and contribute more to my 401K, for retirement. **But now, I am facing a bleak future and looking to lose my home soon as I am struggling to pay my mortgage right now and my savings depleted. I have no healthcare and forced to pay everything out of pocket.

2. I cannot find a job in the geo-spatial field anymore due to the termination label. No one is willing to hire me now, as I am considered damaged goods.

3. Example 1: I was offered a job by a defense contracting company in April 2024, and a week afterward, I received a call from the company telling me they are rescinding my job offer because the DOD contract was rescinded. This continues to happen to me today.

4. Example 2: If an employer finds out about my termination status, they become suspicious of me and begin to discriminate against me. This just happened to me at my, last short-lived job at DHS Savvee Inc.

5. Example 3.: On the web, even job sites are asking me if I have been terminated before they sign me on. They seem to know I was terminated and hard to get hired in the IC industry ever again.

6. Lies are being said about me and tainting my name for the rest of my life.

7. The BuckEYE managers terminated me with no Severance Pay, despite my good record of positive performance for 5 years at Leidos. Co-workers witnessed the unbelievable treatment I received and I was treated very differently.

**Continuous Punishment:

8. Your Honor, no company in the Intelligence Community (IC), is willing to hire me after Leidos Inc. categorized me as "TERMINATED". This means it is no longer possible for me to be hired by any Government Contractor and this is being done deliberately due to political retribution. My name has been character assassinated and potential employers do not even respond to my follow-up emails. It is almost as if someone is making sure I never work again, and I now know why.

9. How will I survive and how will I pay my mortgage if I cannot even find work? My family and I do not deserve to die poor with no money to pay my mortgage and lose our home.

10. Your Honor, this Termination Punishment does not match the "crime" so to speak. My termination is political retribution because (a)- I did not sell company secrets; (b)- I did not betray my country. (c)- I love my adopted country and would rather die than betray it. (d)- I am a Christian and am a Patriotic American just like my deceased husband was. (e)- I know right from wrong. (f) I adhered very strictly to Leidos Inc.'s DEI requirements as I did not want to lose my job (g)- I did not preach my Christian faith to others at work. h)- I was not involved in Politics and did not attend rallies or talk politics at work and do not have social media accounts, except for jobs. (On the other hand, my co-workers were extremely political and discussed it all the time. I did not come to America to engage in politics, and yet my termination seem to be politically motivated. I came to the US to for education and to work hard inoder to take care of my family. I do not deserve what Leidos Inc has done to my life because I am a law-abiding member of society and pay my taxes dutifully, which my husband and I did for 40-years.

11. ***Your Honor, the fact that I could not even find a Lawyer to represent me, is proof enough it is connected to my former employer. The BuckEYE managers, Nick and others, have continued to persecute me, even while I am no longer in their employment. Lawyers never say my case is weak, but are afraid to take up the case and represent me after they realise which Agency Leidos Contracts with. My phones is continually targetted for hacking by them and I do not have safe wifi at home as it is also hacked by them. (Please see attached Pettition and supporting documents).**

**** If Leidos does not compensate me, I stand to lose everything, most importantly, my home.**

**** I am Pleading to The United States Supreme Court to help me and to have mercy on my Case.**
