CERTIFICATE UNDER SUPREME COURT RULE 44.2

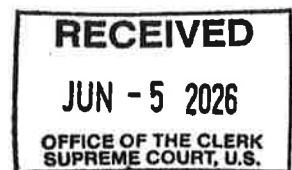
I, Annie-Grace Kline, hereby certify that the grounds for rehearing in the attached petition are limited to intervening circumstances of a substantial or controlling effect. The intervening circumstance upon which rehearing is sought is the United States Department of Justice's May 18, 2026 announcement establishing a \$1.776 billion "Anti-Weaponization Fund," though still under debate in Congress, creates a new remedial process and potential compensation mechanism for persons alleging political targeting and related harms. This Fund was not available at the time the Court denied review and is directly relevant to the questions presented because it may provide relief or compensation that could materially affect the legal and equitable posture of this case. GROUND(S) FOR REHEARING

1. Intervening Circumstance: On May 18, 2026, the United States Department of Justice announced the establishment of a \$1.776 billion "Anti-Weaponization Fund" intended to compensate persons who have been subjected to political targeting or related forms of persecution. That announcement constitutes an intervening circumstance of substantial and controlling effect because the Fund creates a new, government-administered remedy that was not available when the Court denied review.
2. Relation to Petitioner's Case: The existence of the Fund is directly relevant to petitioner's claims and the relief sought here: petitioner has been unable to obtain employment for four years following a termination label asserted to be politically motivated, and petitioner is losing her home as a direct consequence of the termination and resulting unemployment. The Fund's creation presents a new avenue for relief and compensation that could materially alter the legal and equitable considerations in this case and warrants rehearing so the Court may consider the effect of this intervening remedial mechanism on the questions presented. (Petitioner understands arguments against the Fund due to those individuals who actually entered the Houses of Congress, but petitioner never attended the rally and petitioner's spouse (now deceased) never entered the Capitol Hill, but was put under surveillance none-the-less up till his death).
