Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 30.4, the State of Louisiana respectfully requests an extension of 30 days, to and including June 10, 2026, within which to file its brief in opposition to the petition for writ of certiorari in *Mills v. Louisiana*, No. 25-7001. The State's brief in opposition is currently due on May 11, 2026.
