



The motion to dismiss pursuant to MCR 7.211(C)(2) is GRANTED, though for a reason different from the reason asserted by defendant-appellee. The claim of appeal of right is DISMISSED for lack of jurisdiction because the order appealed from, whether it was entered on September 11, 2024, or entered on both September 11, 2024, and September 14, 2024, is not a final order that is appealable by right. MCR 7.203(A)(1). A post-judgment order sanctioning a party for civil contempt is not appealable by right. See MCL 552.631, MCL 552.633, and *In re Moroun*, 295 Mich App 312, 329; 814 NW2d 319 (2012).

Dismissal is without prejudice to the filing of a late application for leave to appeal under MCR 7.205(A)(4), provided that the filing meets the requirements under the court rules and is not time-barred.
