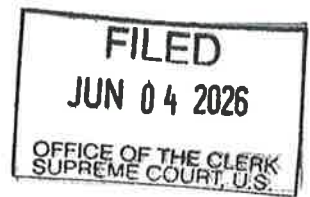

I, Zumar DuBois, certify that the grounds are limited to intervening circumstances of substantial or controlling effect or to other substantial grounds not previously presented; which are:

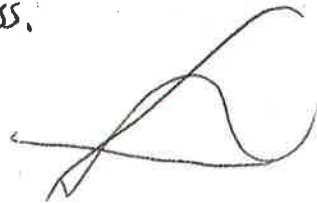
- 1). I received ineffective assistance of Counsel under the Strickland v. Washington standard,

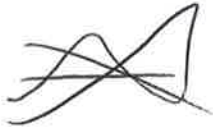
