EMERGENCY MOTION FOR PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND IMMEDIATE RESTRAINING ORDER AGAINST RESPONDENTS AND THEIR CO-CONSPIRITORS

NOW COMES THE PRO SE IFP petitioner Vernon J. Leftridge, Jr. (hereinafter "Petitioner") in the interest of justice, hereby files his emergency motion for permanent injunction and immediate restraining order against the respondents and their co-conspirators for good cause. Petitioner is filing this emergency motion for a permanent injunction and immediate restraining order against the respondents and their co-conspirators. This request is made in the interest of justice and for good cause, involving allegations of organized injustice, obstruction of justice, weaponization of Connecticut Attorney General Office, organized interstate crime, identity theft, fake

Montgomery County Maryland Government UIFSA legal documents, fake Prince George C fraud, and egregious attorney misconduct involving respondent Andrea Gaines, the respondents Andrea Gaines involved and co-conspirators.

This emergency injunction and restraining order motion is submitted while the U.S. Supreme Court considers the petitioner pending corrected Pro se Petition for Writ of Certiorari, Maryland Attorney General and Connecticut Attorney General Waiver before a final disposition has been recorded.

In support of this emergency motion for permanent injunction and restraining order, Petitioner represents the following declaration of facts:

DECLARATION OF UNDISPUTABLE FACTS

I, Vernon J. Leftridge, Jr., declare under U.S.C. 1746 the following undisputed facts under penalties of perjury that the following is true and undisputed:

BACKGROUND

1. On April 14, 2015, Petitioner welcomed his second middle custodial minor-child son R.J.H.L. in Prince George County Maryland Hospital.
2. On April 16, 2015, paternity of Petitioner custodial minor-child son R.J.H.L. was established by State of Maryland Department of Health Vital Records and Prince George County Maryland Government Vital Records.
3. On April 16, 2015, Petitioner custodial minor-child son R.J.H.L. birth certificate was generated and recorded by State of Maryland Department of Health Vital Records Registrar and Clerk of Prince George County Maryland Government Vital Records with Petitioner full name as biological custodial father of R.J.H.L. and custodial mother Niambi Kafi Heyward.

4. On August 1, 2016, Petitioner moved to Commonwealth of Massachusetts after being accepted to attend Suffolk University School of Law.
5. On or about May 1, 2018, Attorney Sean Kehoe of Connecticut Attorney General Office improperly appointed Attorney respondent Andrea Gaines to initiate a Montgomery County Maryland Government UIFSA paternity financial proceeding on behalf of Prince George County Maryland resident Niambi Kafi Heyward against Petitioner while using fake legal documents, fake Montgomery County Maryland Government UIFSA legal document fake, Prince George County Maryland Government birth certificate with Petitioners Prince George County Maryland born custodial middle minor-child son R.J.H.L. identity illegally while Petitioner was living in Massachusetts to attend law school.
6. On April 12, 2018, respondent allegedly appeared before a private UIFSA Magistrate in Hartford Family Connecticut Superior Court by herself with the fake Montgomery County Maryland Government UIFSA illegal document, Niambi Kafi Heyward Prince George County Maryland drivers' license and invented fake Prince George County Maryland illegal birth certificate using Petitioner custodial minor child son R.J.H.L. identity fraudulently.
7. Petitioner was not aware of the fake Montgomery County Government Maryland UIFSA paternity illegal document until his Saratoga, New York employer received a garnishment letter from respondent Connecticut Department of Social to withhold money from Petitioner check for Petitioner custodial minor-child son who has never step foot into Connecticut in light that

Montgomery County Government did not ask State of Connecticut or the Connecticut Attorney General Office to initiate any UIFSA process against the Petitioner.

8. Petitioner filed jury requested federal law suit in U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut in Hartford Connecticut against respondent Andrea Gaines and the respondents she involved for federal rights violations, interstate fraud, other frauds, retaliation, civil rights violations, identity theft, false claims, due process violations and other federal constitutional violations.
9. Attorneys from both Maryland Attorney General and Connecticut Attorney General (hereinafter "Opposing Counsel") appeared on behalf of attorney respondent Andrea Gaines and the respondents she involved before the late U.S. District Court of Connecticut Judge Jeffrey Meyers.
10. A fifteen minute motions hearing took place before the late Judge Jeffrey Meyer without Rule 26f conference statement and jury trial.
11. None of the Maryland respondents, respondent Andrea Gaines or any of the respondents that Andrea Gaines involved did not appear at the motions hearing except Petitioner and opposing counsel.
12. The late Judge Jeffrey Meyer dismissed Petitioner federal law suit based on reliance of opposing counsel representations that respondent Andrea Gaines had legal official right to prosecute a Montgomery County Maryland Government UIFSA paternity action using fake Montgomery County Government legal documents against Petitioner on behalf of Prince George County Maryland resident Niambi Kafi Heyward against Petitioner in a

Connecticut Court because Petitioner appeared to challenge the illegal UIFSA paternity process and fake legal documents.

13. Petitioner filed timely appeal to U.S. Second Circuit Court of Appeals with the required documents and ordered transcripts of the motions hearing due to reversible errors, mistakes, procedural errors, fraud upon court, and due process violations.

14. The lower USCA 2 made clear errors by not allowing Petitioner to file any appeals brief with or without ordered transcripts which is in violation of Petitioner federal constitutional rights to due process. USCA 2 new assigned case manager has acted in a way that suggests bias and procedural violations. In addition, Petitioner is a registered crime victim with respondent Connecticut Judicial Branch Office of Victim Services and has been denied his constitutional rights to due process to file his appeals brief with or without transcripts which is a clear reversible error which is of great public importance. Petitioner is also a victim of an organized manifested injustice where Petitioner, Petitioner children and grand children has suffered irreparable harm, retaliation, weaponization of public offices and severe financial injuries because of the unconstitutional actions of the respondents and the interstate public employees and officers of the court they involved.

15. U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit dismissed appeal after a new case manager was assigned to appeal and based on irrelevant federal cases having nothing to do with the appealed motions hearing, fraud upon court, mistakes, errors and due process violations.

16. On February 17, 2026, Petitioner timely filed a Petition for Writ of Certiorari with the U.S. Supreme Court, appealing procedural and reversible errors made by the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit in Leftridge v. Judicial Branch, et al. (Case Nos. 23-1029, 23-1137, 23-1255). Petitioner corrected the petition as requested by the Clerk of the Supreme Court.
17. Despite the pending petition and notice provided to the USCA 2 Clerk's Office, proceedings, orders and rulings have continued. Petitioner moved that the United States Supreme Court issue an immediate stay and any necessary orders to prevent further rulings by the USCA 2 while Petitioner corrected Petition for Writ of Certiorari is pending before the U.S. Supreme Court.
18. On February 17, 2026, Petitioner timely filed a Petition for Writ of Certiorari in-person at 2:56:46 PM regarding the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit cases Leftridge v. Judicial Branch, et al. (Case Nos. 23-1029, 23-1137, and 23-1255). This petition was corrected as requested by the Clerk's Office, remains pending review.
19. Following the filing of the petition on February 17, the USCA 2 should have stayed all proceedings until the U.S. Supreme Court has had the opportunity to review the corrected petition. Although the USCA 2 Clerk's Office was notified, additional rulings have continued.
20. Accordingly, Petitioner had moved the United States Supreme Court to issue an immediate stay and any necessary orders to prevent further rulings by the USCA 2 while the Petition for Writ of Certiorari is pending and reviewed by the U.S. Supreme Court Justices.

21. Petitioner Motion for Stay of Mandate was initially rejected by the USCA 2 Clerk, but was subsequently restored after the Petition for Writ of Certiorari was filed on February 17, 2026.
22. On March 27, 2026, Petitioner had timely filed an emergency application for a stay of lower federal court proceedings pending the U.S. Supreme Court's review of corrections to Petitioners Petition for Writ of Certiorari. This stay request was based on allegations of egregious organized injustice, obstruction of justice, fraud, and attorney misconduct involving respondent Andrea Gaines of the Connecticut Attorney General's Office, the respondents and co-conspirators that respondent Andrea Gaines involved the lower courts reversible errors and due process violations.

SUMMARY

1. Formal summary regarding the fake Montgomery County Government UIFSA illegal matter initiated by Connecticut attorney respondent Andrea Gaines without Montgomery County Maryland Government knowledge, fake Prince George County Government counterfeit birth certificate with theft of Petitioner custodial son R.J.H.L. identity, weaponization of Connecticut Attorney General Office and the Petition for Writ of Certiorari filed with the U.S. Supreme Court (Case Nos. 23-1029, 23-1137, 23-1255).
2. The core of this matter involves the improper initiation of a Montgomery County, Maryland, UIFSA paternity proceeding by Respondent Andrea Gaines of the Connecticut Attorney General's Office. Despite paternity and birth records being legally established in Prince George's County, Maryland, in April 2015, fraudulent

documents were used to initiate illegal proceedings in Connecticut while Petitioner was a Suffolk School of law student in Massachusetts. Petitioner only became aware of these actions upon the garnishment of Petitioners wages in New York.

3. Following the dismissal of Petitioner federal lawsuit in the U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut and the subsequent dismissal of Petitioner appeal by the U.S. Second Circuit Court of Appeals, Petitioner filed a Petition for Writ of Certiorari on February 17, 2026. This petition addresses reversible errors, fraud upon the court, and due process violations.
4. On March 27, 2026, Petitioner filed an emergency application for a stay of all lower court proceedings. This request was pending before the U.S. Supreme Court but denied by Honorable U.S. Supreme Court Justice Sonia Sotomayor which Petitioner sought to prevent further rulings by the Second Circuit while the Supreme Court reviews Petitioners corrected petition.
5. On April 24, 2026, Montgomery County Maryland Office of Inspector General issued a records investigation results that no Montgomery County Maryland Government agency has no records of Prince George County Maryland resident Niambi Kafi Heyward starting and/or filing any UIFSA petition or any legal documents with any Montgomery County Maryland Government agency.
6. Opposing counsel knowingly and intentionally gave misleading and false statements to late U.S. District Court Judge Jeffrey Meyer when they made a material false representation that Niambi Kafi Heyward completed a UIFSA Paternity or UIFSA child support petition with Montgomery County Maryland

Government to reestablish paternity again for Petitioner custodial minor-child R.J.H.L. which gave respondent Andrea Gaines a right to initiate Maryland Montgomery County Government legal business in Connecticut without consent from Montgomery County Maryland Government.

7. After new developments by Montgomery County Office of Inspector General Investigators and newly discovered material evidence that opposing counsel committed intentional fraud upon the lower U.S. District Courts, Petitioner filed Emergency Rule 11 Sanctions motion for obstruction of justice, attorney misconduct and fraud upon court.
8. Petitioner will provide further updates as the lower U.S. District Court Judge Omar Williams issues its rulings on pending Rule 11 sanctions against opposing counsel for attorney misconduct, fraud upon U.S. District Court and acts that warrant criminal contempt of court.

**REASONS FOR GRANTING PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND IMMEDIATE
RESTRAINING ORDER AGAINST RESPONDENTS**

There is a ongoing manifested injustice where Petitioner and his five custodial children have suffered irreparable injuries, have continued to suffer irreparable injuries because of the unlawful actions of respondent Andrea Gaines and all the respondents she involved in the illegal fake Montgomery County Government documents scam, Prince George County birth certificate fraud and identity theft. The irreparable harm by the respondents is ongoing and is a very high likelihood that it will continue if the U.S. Supreme Court doesn't permanently stop it once and for all to prevent further retaliation and irreparable injuries by respondent Andrea Gaines and the respondents she involved

with her fake legal documents financial scam. Permanent injunction and immediate restraining order serves the interest of the public and protects U.S. American citizens from similar UIFSA scams and fraudulent acts.

Petitioner and his family have continued to suffer loss of federal rights, unnecessary financial harm, loss of due process, retaliation and ongoing irreparable harm if U.S. Supreme Court doesn't stop the egregious attorney misconduct, scam cover-up, obstruction of justice and fraud upon federal courts.

There is a strong likelihood that U.S. Supreme Court will reverse the lower court's decision upon final review. It is also strongly likely that the U.S. Supreme Court Justices will accept Petitioner Case and hear arguments on the merits. The balance of justice favors the Petitioner and his custodial minor children. An immediate restraining order will prevent on-going risk of harm to the Petitioner and his family which outweighs any potential harm to the opposing parties if this permanent injunction and immediate restraining order emergency motion is granted. An emergency injunction and immediate restraining order is necessary for this federal case to maintain legal precedence, prevent on-going manifested injustice, stop witch hunt and weaponization of Connecticut Attorney General Office, protect Petitioner and his custodial minor children federal constitutional rights to due process and protect Petitioners custodial children from exploitation, identity theft and interference with private Maryland vital records.

CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, Petitioner VERNON JAMES LEFTRIDGE, JR., respectfully requests his emergency motion for injunction and immediate restraining order be granted in the interest of justice and for all the forgoing reasons, including issuing any other reasonable orders,

and relief that this U.S. Supreme Court deems reasonable, fair, just and appropriate regarding the new development Montgomery County Office of Inspector General Records Investigation Report.

3. Order that the lower U.S. District Court Case Judgment be vacated due to obstruction, attorney misconduct, and intentional fraud upon the court by opposing counsel.
4. Order the case remanded to the U.S. District Court to be reopened, with judgment entered in favor of the Petitioner-Plaintiff due to developments substantiating fraud upon the court by the opposing parties and counsel.
5. Grant any other relief in law or equity that the U.S. Supreme Court deems appropriate and proper.


