State court case 2006DR19002 issued second supplemental Judgment on 12/26/25 that reduced both alimony and child support to 34% of prior support. This is after I removed my petition for increased support due to a denial of due process and after I had filed a federal case 6:24cv1987 in the middle district (denial of due process) against judges, attorneys and my former husband etc. I was not solvent when I was receiving last years support (\$11,781), not able to pay for care for my son, taxes or our bills and was living on assets. Now the total support will not allow us to pay for both rent and food let alone health insurance, car insurance. The same state family court turned a blind eye to emergency motions for my son's care and caused me to have to sell my home that was completely paid off in 2016 six years after I file a supplemental petition. Additionally see the Attached statement and court ordered support reduction.
