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**Application for Permission to Proceed In Forma Pauperis**

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## APPLICATION TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Petitioner, Adam Carey, seeks leave to file the enclosed Petition for Writ of Certiorari without prepayment of costs and to proceed in forma pauperis in accordance with Supreme Court Rule 39. In support of his application, Mr. Carey states the following:

The United District Court for the Middle District of Tennessee found Mr. Carey indigent and permitted him to proceed in forma pauperis. The district court appointed undersigned counsel pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A (Criminal Justice Act) and 18 U.S.C. § 3599.<sup>1</sup> Similarly, the United States Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit permitted Mr. Carey to proceed in forma pauperis on appeal. In accordance with Supreme Court Rule 39, no affidavit of indigency from Mr. Carey is required.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner seeks leave to proceed in forma pauperis. The motion should be granted.
