Petitioner, ANDREW RICHARD LUKEHART, by and through undersigned counsel, asks leave of this Court, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, to proceed *in forma pauperis* without prepayment of costs in connection with his application for a stay of execution and petition for a writ of certiorari.
