I represent Respondent in the above-captioned case. Petitioner filed a petition for a writ of certiorari on December 23, 2025, which was placed on the docket on December 31, 2025. A brief in opposition is currently due January 30, 2026. I write pursuant to Rule 30.4 to respectfully request a 30-day extension of time to file the opposition, to and including March 1, 2026. Petitioner takes no position on the request.

An extension of time is warranted because I have prior deadlines in other matters between now and the end of January, including an oral argument on January 15, 2026 in *American Association of University Professors v.
