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ARGUMENT

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

I. Plaintiff Appellant Harold Noel ("Appellant") brought this appeal opposing the trial court's Order Granting Defendants' Motion to Dismiss. Appellant asserts the trial court erred in granting the Motions to Dismiss for William Gibbons, Mark Luttrell, Shelby County Healthcare Corporation d/b/a Regional One Health ("Regional One"), and Shelby County Jail and Correctional Center. The appellant further asserts that he did state a claim upon which relief can be granted as the doctrine of sovereign immunity did not apply and the statute of limitations for the healthcare claim had not passed when the claim was asserted.

II. Proceedings and disposition below
On May 16, 2023, the Appellant filed a Complaint for Damages. A Motion to Dismiss Defendant William Gibbons and a Memorandum in Support of Motion to Dismiss were filed on June 22, 2023. On June 23, 2023, an Answer was filed on behalf of Shelby County Government. On July 31, 2023, a Motion to Dismiss Defendant Regional One. Subsequently, an Order Granting the Defendants' Motion to Dismiss was entered on September 28, 2023. On October 30, 2023, the Appellant filed a Notice of Appeal in the Circuit Court of Tennessee for the Thirtieth Judicial District of Memphis.

REASONS FOR GRANTING THE PETITION

Those criminal acts placing chips, tracking devices, FRID, monitoring devices on my body unconstitutionally evil crime against me, every one involved be held accountable and punished with jail time etc...
