**Re: *Dershowitz v. Cable News Network, Inc.*, No. 25-770**

Dear Mr. Harris:

We represent Respondent Cable News Network, Inc. in the above-captioned matter. Pursuant to Rule 30.4 of this Court, Respondent respectfully requests a 30-day extension of the deadline to file a Brief in Opposition to Alan M. Dershowitz's Petition for Writ of Certiorari, from March 19, 2026, to April 17, 2026.

The Petition was initially due November 27, 2025, and, following an extension granted by Justice Thomas, was filed on December 29, 2025. Respondent filed a waiver of its right to respond to the Petition on January 30, 2026. On February 17, 2026, the Court requested that Respondent file a response by March 19, 2026.

Respondent respectfully requests that its time to file a Brief in Opposition to the Petition be extended to April 17, 2026. A 30-day extension of time to file the response is justified, given that the Petition raises a number of complex issues and was also prepared with the benefit of a 30-day extension of time. The requested extension is necessary for Respondent to prepare an appropriate response to the Petition.
