I am counsel of record for Respondents Ben Henry, Director of the Arizona Department of Liquor Licenses and Control; Troy Campbell, Chair of the Arizona State Liquor Board; and Arizona Attorney General Kris Mayes. I am writing on behalf of all Respondents, including, with counsel's permission, Respondent Wine and Spirits Wholesalers Association of Arizona.

On December 30, 2025, Petitioners Reed Day and Albert Jacobs filed a Petition for Writ of Certiorari, which was docketed on January 6, 2026.
