MOTION FOR LEAVE TO DISPENSE WITH PREPARATION OF JOINT APPENDIX

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Pursuant to Rule 26.8 of the Rules of this Court, Petitioner respectfully seeks leave to dispense with the requirement of a joint appendix.

Rule 26.1 provides that the joint appendix need not include any items that are already reproduced in the appendix to the petition for writ of certiorari. In this case, the appendix to the petition for a writ of certiorari includes the relevant materials from the Second Circuit and District Court. In Petitioner's view, no other portion of the record merits special attention such as would warrant the preparation and expense of a joint appendix, and preparation of a joint appendix would not materially assist the Court's consideration of the case.
