**JOINT MOTION FOR LEAVE TO DISPENSE
WITH PREPARATION OF A JOINT APPENDIX**

Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 26.8, the parties respectfully move for leave to dispense with filing a joint appendix.

This case presents solely a question of standing, which was decided at the motion to dismiss stage. The district court's order dismissing the case for lack of standing, the opinion affirming that order, the order denying rehearing en banc, as well as the various statements of the three judges who dissented from the denial of rehearing en banc, are included in the appendix to the petition for a writ of certiorari. So too is the Verified First Amended Complaint which the lower courts analyzed for standing at the pleading stage. Other materials that Respondents considered relevant at the certiorari stage, including an agency policy and memo the Complaint quotes and references, are included in the appendix to the brief in opposition.

No other portion of the record merits special attention such as would warrant the preparation and expense of a joint appendix. And a joint appendix would not materially assist the Court in its consideration of this case.

For these reasons, the joint motion should be granted.
