
Dear Mr. Bickell:

I am counsel for Respondent in the above-referenced case. On January 16, 2026, a certiorari petition was filed in this case. Unless extended by the Court, a response is due February 23, 2026. For the reasons that follow, and pursuant to Rule 30.4, Respondent respectfully requests an extension of 30 days, to and including March 25, 2026.

I have only recently been retained in this case, and, in light of multiple briefing deadlines and an oral argument scheduled in the coming weeks, the additional time is necessary to allow an opportunity to prepare a response that adequately addresses the points raised in the petition. This is Respondent's first request for an extension. Petitioner received a 45-day extension of time to file the petition.
