Dear Mr. Harris:

We represent Respondent Donte J. Carter in the above-captioned case. The Court docketed the petition for a writ of certiorari on January 28, 2026, after the United States received extensions of time for 30 days and 28 days, respectively. Following a 30-day extension of time, Mr. Carter's response is currently due March 30, 2026.

Pursuant to this Court's Rules 15.3 and 30.4, Respondent respectfully requests a 30-day extension, to April 29, 2026, to file his response. The extension is necessary given the heavy press of other business. Between the current and requested deadlines, my colleagues and I have needed and must continue to attend to other matters, including certiorari-stage briefing before this Court, merits-stage briefing before this Court (*Bondi v.
