Dear Mr. Bickell:

I am writing to clarify our reasons for filing a Motion for Leave to File an Amicus Brief in the above-entitled matter.

The attorney who normally formats and files amicus briefs for the Foundation left his position with the Foundation to assume a position with the Alabama Attorney General February 1. I spoke with him earlier this evening and he does not recall whether he notified the parties of our intent to file an amicus brief, and because of a massive hack on my Juno email, I am unable to determine whether I notified the parties.
