Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition in the above-captioned matter was filed on February 6, 2026, and placed on the Court's docket on February 11, 2026. Respondents filed a waiver of their right to respond on February 17, 2026. On March 11, 2026, the Court called for a response. Absent an extension, the brief in opposition would be due April 10, 2026. Pursuant to Rules 15.3 and 30.4 of this Court, respondents AT&T Mobility LLC and Nokia of America Corporation respectfully request that the time to file a response be extended by 60 days, to and including June 9, 2026. We also request that the extension of time apply to all respondents.

The extension is necessary because of the press of other matters.<sup>1</sup> The additional time is also necessary to ensure appropriate coordination between the separately represented respondents for AT&T and Nokia and to allow them sufficient time to prepare a single, consolidated response that will be helpful to the Court.


