On behalf of petitioners Yellow Corporation and its affiliated debtors and debtors in possession (collectively, “Yellow”), I write to inform the Court that Yellow has entered into individual settlement agreements (the “Settlements”) with the following respondents in the above-referenced case (collectively, the “Settling Respondents”), which Settlements were approved by orders of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware in the jointly administered chapter 11 cases of *In re Yellow Corporation, et al.*, Case No. 23-11069 (CTG) on April 22 and April 23, 2026:

- Central States, Southeast and Southwest Areas Pension Fund;
- Freight Drivers and Helpers 557 Pension;
- Mid-Jersey Trucking Industry & Teamsters Local 701 Pension and Annuity Fund;
- Road Carriers Local 707 Pension Fund;

- Trucking Employees of North Jersey Pension Fund.

Yellow’s Settlements with the Settling Respondents do not affect the ongoing dispute and questions presented in the petition for writ of certiorari between, on the one hand, Yellow, and, on the other hand, the following non-settling respondents (collectively, the “Non-Settling Respondents”) and respondent Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation.

- Teamsters Local 617 Pension Fund; and
- Management Labor Pension Fund Local 1730.
