PETITIONER'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE THE
PETITION FOR WRIT OF CERTIORARI

PURSUANT to applicable United States Supreme Court Rules, the Petitioner respectfully moves this Honorable Court to extend the time in which he has to file the "Petition for Writ of Certiorari." See 28 U.S.C. § 2101(c); Rule 13.1, Supreme Court Rules (petition for writ of certiorari must be filed within 90 days after entry of the judgment or decree in the court of appeals).

Reasons to Grant this Motion

1. Petitioner is a state prisoner housed alone on a higher security status unable to visit the prison's law library and conduct his own legal research but must submit request forms to the law and depend on the prison's law clerks obtain the information in which he seeks.
2. One of the issues the Petitioner intends to present as an issue sufficient to warrant certiorari review seems to be unprecedented for the law clerks insist that no legal authority is available which empowers the Court of Appeals the authority to resolve the appeal in the manner it partially did nor have any Federal Circuit Court of Appeals seems to have any case laws where this type of resolution occurred in the past.






