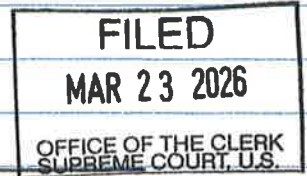

COMES NOW THE PETITIONER, Denis Chavez, acting pro se, unlettered at law, and submits this Motion for Extension of Time With Judicial Notice, to this Honorable United States Supreme Court.

Petitioner brings to the attention of the Court the following facts and information:

1. On December 23, 2025, Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus was docketed by the Supreme Court of Florida.
2. On December 23, 2025, the Court, citing a lack of jurisdiction, dismissed the Petition.
3. On March 13, 2026, Petitioner filed a Notice of Inquiry and request for Docket Statement with the Supreme Court of Florida.
4. On March 13, 2026, the Court forwarded a Docket Sheet, a cover letter, and a copy of the Order on the disposition of the case, to the Petitioner (see attachments).
5. On March 20, 2026, Petitioner received the Docket Sheet and Order.
6. It appears that the Florida Supreme Court dismissed this case on December 29, 2025.

7. Petitioner did not receive notice of that dismissal until March 20, 2026. (Please see date stamp on Order and envelope)
8. Under normal circumstances, Petitioner's Petition for Writ of Certiorari would have a ninety (90) day deadline, and that filing date would be March 29, 2026.
9. Petitioner submits that the failure of the Florida Supreme Court to notify the Petitioner of its dismissal of his Petition for Writ of Habeas Corpus, has jeopardized Petitioner's ability to submit his Petition for Writ of Certiorari, within the statutory deadline.
10. Petitioner further submits that with the law library schedule time scarce in this institution, he has no time to make the March 29, 2026 deadline, with a statutorily correct Petition for Writ of Certiorari.
11. Petitioner respectfully requests that this Honorable Court grant him the ninety (90) days allotted by statute to submit his Petition for Writ of Certiorari.
12. Petitioner respectfully requests that this Honorable Court grant him an extension of time, up to and including June 20, 2026,

in which to file his Petition

13. Petitioner further requests that this Court forward to him the correct paperwork for submitting a Petition for Writ of Certiorari, and the Supreme Court Procedural Handbook, both of which are not available in this institution.
