Dear Honorable Justice Kavanaugh:

I, Paulette Long, am an Appellant working to submit a Petition for Writ of Certiorari in the above-referenced case. The respondent is Elizabeth Z. Woodward, Appellee.

As a pro se litigant, I respectfully request a further extension of time to and including July 3, 2026, to file a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari concerning the case referenced above.

More time is needed because I have experienced eye treatments and am involved in a series of eye surgeries that have limited my ability to secure counsel and to retrieve documents from the pertinent files and conduct applicable research in support of preparing and filing the Petition.

An additional second surgery has been performed since I requested the first extension of time and a third laser surgery will be performed on June 16th as a result of complications with the second surgery.

I need more time to prepare and submit Petition documents as I am working with sight in one eye at the moment. However, a third follow-up surgery is being performed by Dr. Mastrobattista, MD on the 16th of June which will clear the vision in my left eye before the newly requested deadline.

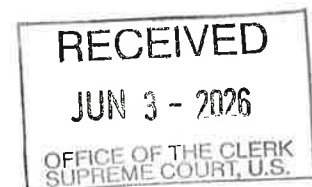
I have attached a letter from Dr. Mastrobattista, MD, confirming the medical surgeries and treatments I have and continue to receive from his offices and hospital.

Re: Confirmation of the Care, Treatment and Surgery Provided to Paulette Long and Her anticipated Prognosis to Support her Request for a Further Extension of Time to Submit a Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Supreme Court of The United States

Dear Honorable Justice Kavanaugh:

I am the ophthalmologist for Paulette Long, an Appellant working to submit a Petition for Writ of Certiorari to the Supreme Court of The United States.

I have been treating Paulette Long for a period of several months for loss of vision requiring cataract and laser surgery. I confirm that she can see clearly out of only her right eye at the moment, and second laser surgery is required on the left eye on June 16th.

I can confirm that we anticipated that vision in both eyes would have been restored in time to meet the June 5th deadline, however, there were unforeseen circumstances with the vision in her left eye uncovered during the surgery and will require additional surgery and treatment.

She informed me last week that she would try to submit the Petition for a Writ of Certiorari by the June 5, deadline as she thought her sight would improve but it has not. I respectfully request that my patient be given an extension of time as she requested for July 3, 2026, because the result of her surgery has not provided the sight we expected to have by the originally extended deadline of June 5, 2026.

I believe that the June 16th surgery will clear the vision in her left eye before the newly requested deadline of July 3rd.
