Reasons why application should be granted

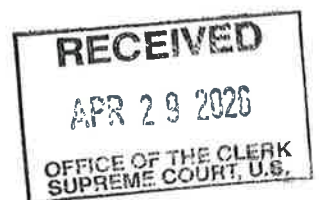
