
Request for Extension of Time to File Possible Petition for Writ of Certiorari (Rule 13.5)

Declaration

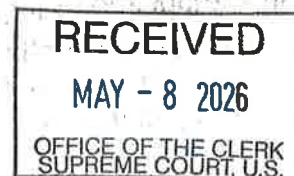
