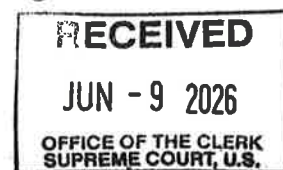
I'm requesting for an extension of 90 days to file my petition for a
