**VERIFIED SECOND HARDSHIP MOTION
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLY**

Comes now, Rustin P. Wright, Petitioner, moving under extreme financial hardship for an extension with which to comply with the Court's April 20th Order, thusly:

- A. On April 20th, 2026, my motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* was denied, and I was ordered to pay the docketing fee and to submit a Petition in compliance with Rule 33.1 of the Rules of this Court by May 11th, 2026.
- B. During the meantime since, I submitted and was later returned by the Clerk multiple related motions at various times, all now superseded by this motion.
- C. Due to my financial hardship, I can comply with paying the \$300 docketing fee, but for reasons given by said prior motions, particularly a voluminous Appendix requiring multiple Volumes if I maintained all three (3) Questions as per my prior Rule 33.2 submissions, I cannot afford to keep all three (3) of those Questions under Rule 33.1, but I am forced to limit solely to Question 1.

- D. Accordingly, I now seek through and including **June 30th, 2026** to submit my newly streamlined package of petition using prior Question 1 only, together with significantly reduced Appendix, all in compliance with Rule 33.1.
- E. I fully believe and assert that the various contentions and arguments within my Petition are good and meritorious, and further that they are also worthy of the Court's focus upon clarifying important issues of national significance.
- F. In particular, this case presents a uniquely clean vehicle for the Court to address, clarify and/or otherwise provide guidance upon the national advent of court e-filing systems, particularly if/when a State mandates e-filing only.
- G. As the time is already short now, I must act in faith and already proceed with redrafting / streamlining my submission package, even before the Court rules on this final motion for procedural relief.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned Petitioner, Rustin P. Wright, moves the Court for an extension of time, through and including **June 30th, 2026**, within which to redraft and submit said streamlined package, further praying for all other proper relief.


