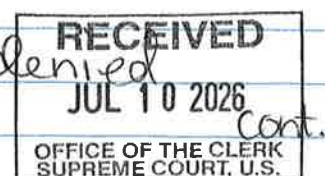

SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Petitioner, Manuel A. Ayala, pro se, respectfully asks this honorable court for a second extension - 60 days of time to file his petition for certiorari, regarding the decision of the U.S. 11th CIRCUIT COURT OF APPEAL in Case No. 25-11867.

In support, petitioner states

1. After the District court denied Petitioner's application for 2254 habeas Corpus, petitioner appealed to the U.S. 11th Circuit Court of Appeal.
2. On January 6th, 2026, the 11th Circuit denied petitioner's application for Certificate of Appealability.
3. On March 2, 2026, the 11th Circuit denied



Petitioner's Motion for Reconsideration, making petitioner's 90 day deadline for Certiorari, May 31, 2026

4. In March of 2026, Petitioner was incarcerated at the MAYO CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION ANNEX, and a law clerk there was assigned to type Petitioner's finished Certiorari petition.
5. Prior to completion of typing Petitioner's Certiorari Petition, Petitioner was transferred to the FRANKLIN CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION, without being allowed to retrieve his legal paperwork from the law library, i.e., Petitioner's Certiorari Petition.
6. Petitioner has been awaiting for the completed typed Certiorari Petition from the MAYO CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION ANNEX Law LIBRARY, But said paperwork has not arrived to the FRANKLIN CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTION, where Petitioner is presently housed.
7. Petitioner has documented the request(s) for the completed typed Certiorari Petition that are at the Petitioner's prior institution. To date, there has not been any legal documents mailed to Petitioner's present institution.
8. Petitioner filed for an EXTENSION OF TIME with this Honorable court on May 29, 2026.
9. On June 24th, 2026, Petitioner received

NOTIFICATION from this Honorable court giving Petitioner a 15 day Extension of time to file Petitioner's writ of certiorari, this extension was authorized by Justice THOMAS on June 15th, 2026.

10. ON June 26, and June 29th, 2026, the LAW LIBRARY WAS closed.

11. Petitioner did submit an informal grievance concerning the matter of Petitioner's finished typed Certiorari Petition.

12. To date, Petitioner's has yet to receive Petitioner's Completed writ of Certiorari from Petitioner's prior Institution.

13. Petitioner will have as a last resort to begin anew compiling Petitioner's writ of certiorari, but will have to apply for a copy from the 11th Circuit Court of Appeal the opinion for the denial of Petitioner's application for Certificate of Appealability.

Therefore, considering the facts stated above, Petitioner humbly Requests for an additional extension of time of 60 days. to format and complete Petitioner's writ of Certiorari.
