a. I request an extension of time to file the petition. I need time to recover from a fall on 9/26/25, when I exited a bus.

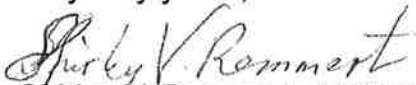

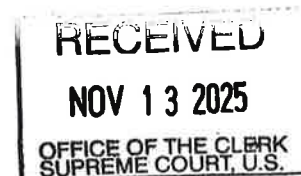
